Information About Bulldog Rescue

- **WHAT IS “BULLDOG RESCUE”?**

The Bulldog Club of Utah’s Rescue Committee rescues lost, abandoned and unwanted Bulldogs and places all adoptable Bulldogs in new homes.

- **WHERE DO THESE BULLDOGS COME FROM?**

The majority are surrendered by their owners who can no longer keep them. About one third of our rescue dogs come from local animal shelters and humane societies.

- **CAN I GET A PUPPY FROM BULLDOG RESCUE?**

No. The average age for the dogs that fall under our care is between 3-5 years, although 7+ years has been the norm this year.

- **IS IT DIFFICULT FOR AN OLDER DOG TO ADAPT TO A NEW HOME?**

Although a period of adjustment is expected, the vast majority of our rescue dogs adapt very well regardless of their age. They seem to have an amazing ability to know when they have found a good home.

- **WHAT IS THE COST OF ADOPTING A RESCUE DOG?**

The Bulldog Club of Utah does not have a set fee for placement since the needs of the dogs vary greatly. All animals must be spayed or neutered prior to placement. Some have medical problems that need treatment. The veterinary expenses incurred in rehabilitating the dog are passed along to the new adoptive owner.

- **HOW MANY DOGS DO YOU PLACE EACH YEAR?**

There is no “average” number—but it is sadly increasing every year.

- **HOW DO I APPLY FOR A RESCUE DOG?**

Contact any member of the rescue committee. Your application will be reviewed and if you are found to be a suitable home, you will be placed on our waiting list. It is not necessary to contact more than one committee member.

- **HOW LONG DOES IT TAKE TO GET A DOG?**

We can not give you an estimated time frame for adoption. The individual needs of each dog are evaluated and the best possible match is selected from our pool of applicants. For example, if we have a dog to place that does not get along with cats, we pass all applicants with cats and look for a “no cats” home.
